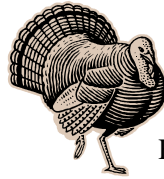

required to report back to school at 3 PM (meet in the Chapel).

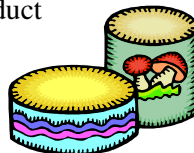
