Hurricane Katrina Relief Efforts.

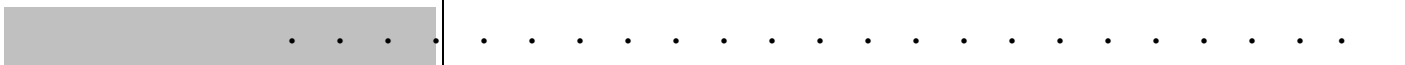

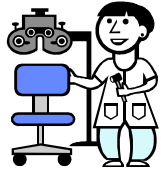
First Mid-Quarter is Upon Us

Lions Sight Van to be at MdC

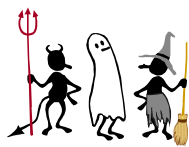
On Thursday, September 22, beginning at 12:45 PM, the Lions Club will have its
